Location:	Golf Resort Achental is located in Grassau in between Kampenwand Mountain and Lake Chiemsee. Lake Chiemsee is only six kilometers away.
Design:	Natural materials and warm colours dominate the hotel's interior design. Old brushed wood, high-quality leather, felt and loden cloth as well as natural daylight create a cosy atmosphere. Open fireplaces, antlers and design furniture underline the modern alpine flair of the resort.





Rooms and Suites:	Junior Suite "Wilder Kaiser" (67 sqm) Junior Suite 210 (45 sqm) Hofzimmer (30 sqm) Comfort Room Salzburg (28 sqm) Superior Room Salzburg (31 sqm) Comfort Room Geigelstein (27 sqm) Standard Double Room Kampenwand (25 sqm) Standard Single Room Kampenwand and Alpenblick (17 sqm) The 210 rooms and suites are equipped with a double or single bed, Loewe flat screen, leather armchair, writing desk and minibar. The newly-appointed bathrooms include natural stone, wooden washstands, bathroom fittings by Dornbracht, rain showers and partly freestanding bath tubs. Almost all rooms have a balcony or terrace. All rooms are non-smoking rooms.
Restaurant:	 Weißer Hirsch (approx. 130 seats) with large terrace Weinstube (approx. 70 seats) with large terrace Kaminzimmer (50 seats) Jagdstube (14 seats) Reiterstube (12 seats) Hubertushütte (40 seats) with barbecue area, located in the garden Golf Lounge (30 seats) with large lounge terrace Kaminbar (20 seats) with open fireplace The culinary team pampers guests in the different restaurant
	areas. In the morning an extensive breakfast buffet is served at "Weißer Hirsch" while guests are awaited with regional delicacies and healthy vitality cuisine in the evenings. Food is served "à la carte" at the "Weinstube". A special highlight is the adjacent walk-in wine cellar. Weather permitting the numerous terraces invite guests to linger. The cosy rooms "Kaminzimmer", "Reiterstube" and "Jagdstube" offer the ideal setting for a private dinner. The Alpine mountain hut "Hubertushütte" is incorporated in the spacious garden estate of the hotel and is available for events in a rustic-style Bavarian atmosphere. Typical local delicacies such as Kässpatz'n and Kaiserschmarr'n are served here.





The hotel's own 18-hole golf course is directly adjacent to the spacious garden estate of the resort and offers incomparable views onto the Alps.

In line with the region's moor landscape, bodies of water and wetlands shape the golf course's appearance. It is characterized by modern design, spacious greens and tees, fairways modeled in an interesting manner and large lakes as well as natural meadows with senior tree population and a beautiful view of the mountains. The halfway house with sun terrace is perfect for a break by the lake.

The green fee amounts to 69 euros from Monday to Thursday and 89 euros on weekends. The costs for an annual golf membership including membership at the German Golf Association DGV are 1,790 euros. The cost for a trial entry without DGV ticket amounts to 299 euros (three months from license exam, use of training facilities, use of 18-hole golf course only possible in combination with golf course proficiency course).

The golf academy provides spacious training facilities and courses for both beginners and advanced golfers.

Pro-Shop, caddy room, changing rooms and a golf lounge complement the offer. The golf course and the training facilities are accessible directly from the resort.

Wellness & Spa:The resort's wellness building offers relaxation across more
than 2,000 square meters. At the spa, guests are pampered
with innovative treatments and products by Ericson Laboratoire
Paris and Team Dr. Joseph.
